

**Maddock City Council
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, March 10, 2026**

Mayor Sarah Dove called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall. Present for roll call were council members Bradley Hermanson, Deedee Olson, Dusty Pierson, and Teresa Dosch. Also in attendance were Jamie Green, Keith Winson, and Laura Wanzek.

A motion was made by Hermanson, seconded by Dosch, to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2026 regular meeting. All voting yes, motion carried.

Sheriff Laura Wanzek was present to discuss the Police Service Contract. Topics discussed included dog handling and transporting, impound fees, and dance fees. The Police Service Contract will begin on April 1, 2026.

Jamie Greens's Report:

- He reported that the picnic tables are being refurbished.

- Discussed painting the transformer boxes in town.
- Discussed purchasing a transfer pump for watering new trees and flower baskets.

Keith Winson's Report:

- LED street lights are being installed in town.
- Reported a water break on Highway 30.
- Received a quote from Northern Plains Electric to install power to the South Maddock sign.
- Called Double M Sanitation regarding dumpsters for the 125th Celebration.
- Lift station inspection.

Pam Lee's Report:

- Discussed church water usage.

The council discussed a new Public Sewer Back-Up and Water Main Break Coverage Endorsement being offered by the North Dakota Insurance Reserve Fund.

There was discussion on the campsite service upgrade project. The council decided to delay the project until additional grant funding may become available and the budget allows.

There was discussion regarding charging the three churches for water usage since the city's water treatment plant was purchased from Central Plains Water District. As a result of this change, the city must now pay for all water used through the system.

A motion was made by Hermanson, seconded by Olson, to begin charging the churches for water usage effective June 1, 2026. Roll call vote: Hermanson yea, Olson yea, Pierson yea, and Dosch nay. Motion carried.

There was discussion on the city's monetary contribution for the 125th Celebration. A motion was made by Olson, seconded by Hermanson, to pay for law enforcement for Thursday, July 30, Friday, July 31, and Saturday, August 1. All voting yes, motion carried.

A motion was made by Hermanson, seconded by Pierson, to approve a building permit for James & Marie Fragodt for a custom home with full basement. All voting yes, motion carried.

The council members each gave a portfolio report.

Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m. The next regular council meeting will be April 14, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.
